 Maths This half term we will be: Completing our learning about decimals Exploring percentages and their relationships with fractions and decimals Learning about the properties of shapes, including: the link between 3D shapes and their 2D representations drawing and measuring - acute, obtuse and reflex angles In addition, weekly arithmetic will be sent home on a Friday to be returned for the following Friday to be marked in class. 	English This half term the children will be extending their writing skills by studying the classic American children's book, <i>Holes</i> by Louis Sachar. We will be exploring the plot, characters, setting and themes, then comparing it to some of the other texts we have read as a class. To help at home, your child should continue to read a wide selection of different texts and practise their spellings regularly.
