World War Two

We have had a great start to this wonderful topic in Autumn 1 and have lots more to cover, so we will be continuing to learn about World War right up until the end of the Autumn term. Events include:

- On <u>Monday 13th November</u>, we will be having a visit from the Blitz School who will provide
 us with a hands-on experience of some World War Two artefacts. Your child is welcome
 to wear a World World Two themed outfit for the day.
- On <u>Wednesday 22nd November</u>, we will be visiting the Yorkshire Sculpture Park for a self-guided tour of the Henry Moore exhibition by our artist in residence, Sharon Snaylam.
 We will gain inspiration from his work to enable us to design and make clay sculptures back in class.
- On <u>Friday 1st December</u>, it is our year group assembly which will be World War Two
 themed. It would be great if your child could come in a World War Two outfit for the day.
- Designing and making poppies to sell to our school community to help raise funds for the Royal British Legion.
- Creating and following a traditional World War Two rationing recipe.
- Exploring what Christmas was like during the war.




Maths

- Statistics
- Multiplication and Division (written and mental methods)


