
Topic

Our topic this term is 'On the Move!'. We will be learning about different types of transport.



We will be reading Cinderella, Mrs Armitage on Wheels, The Naughty Bus, The Train Ride, How to Catch a Star, Man in the Moon and Whatever Next. As part of the topic we will be walking down to Saltaire train station and going on a train ride and we will also be visiting the park and canal to look at the barges.

PE

We will be beginning small sessions of PE in the hall.

The children will be exploring different ways to travel. We will also be learning simple dance movements to music.

PE kit will not be needed.

Train Ride

The first story we will be reading is *The Train Ride*. To support this we will be taking the children on a short train ride to Keighley station. We are provisionally planning this for Monday morning 8th January — weather permitting. Please make sure your child wears sensible footwear and a warm coat.

Sustrans Bike Project

We are involved in an exciting project where children in Reception will be learning how to ride a 2 wheeled bike. This will initially be on balance bikes. If the children make good progress they will move on to using pedal bikes. A separate letter which explains the project in more detail will be sent out.

Books

Please keep reading books in your child's bookbag throughout the week so we can read with them in school. We advise that you spend 10 minutes a day reading or practising tricky words with your child. If your child needs new tricky words, please let us know. Library books continue to be changed on a Friday. If any parents could spare some time to help with reading please speak to your child's class teacher.

Independence

It is really important to foster independence in our children. The children are doing so well and making so much progress with this. You could support us at home by encouraging your child to get dressed independently, including zipping coats and putting on shoes. You could let your child use their own cutlery and let them help at home with laying the table, washing up and making their beds!

Outdoor Resources

We are developing our resources for lunchtime. If, after Christmas you are making room for new toys, we would give a good home to any toys or books still in good condition.
