Throughout the summer, a substantial building project has been completed, developing the old Year 3 cloakroom into a brand-new entrance and office. The autumn term is an exciting and busy time with lots of interesting work planned to stimulate and engage our children in their learning. I have provided a list of useful dates below to keep you informed of what is going on and your class teachers will soon provide newsletters about specific activities in your year groups. This first week has seen our children working with our artist in residence, Sharon Snaylam to think about the concept of learning journeys and what they mean to us as champion learners. She has been working with the children to create some fantastic artwork representing this theme and children have been asked to make a pledge of what they would like to achieve this year. It will be interesting to see how our children work together to achieve their pledges.

Children will soon begin PE lessons and your class teachers will inform you about which days these will take place. As in previous years, children will be able to come to school on these days dressed in PE kit. Please can I remind you that this should be blue shorts or jogging bottoms and a white t-shirt in line with our uniform guidance (no football shirts or different coloured clothing please). PE kit forms part of our school uniform and so we expect all children to wear the appropriate clothing. Please speak to your class teacher if you have any further questions.

In a few weeks, we will be holding our first 'On Time, Ready to Learn' week of the year. Mrs Stoker, Miss Walton (our learning mentor) and I will be looking out for all children who arrive at school before the bell goes in the morning, showing they are on time, prepared and ready for the day ahead. There will be some great prizes to be won for some of the children who do so throughout the year.
