We hope you all had a lovely Easter holiday. We are really looking forward to our Buckden visit next week as it kick starts our Stone Age topic. 3B will be visiting Buckden on the $23^{rd}-24^{th}$ April and 3F will be visiting on the $24^{th}-25^{th}$ April.

During this half term we will be learning all about the Stone Age, its place in history and what life was like so long ago. Whilst staying in Buckden, we shall take a walk to explore an ancient stone circle located nearby and we will be creating our very own cave paintings.

The children have received Times table Rockstar logins, which can assist them in practising their times tables.

As the weather begins to improve both PE lessons will take place outside, the children will be learning how to play tennis and practising their athletic skills in preparation for sports day. PE will continue to take place on a Monday and Thursday, please ensure your child comes to school in the appropriate PE kit as described in the school's uniform policy. In science the children will be starting a new topic and learning about plants, we will be visiting the Hirst Wood nature reserve to explore plants on Tuesday 8th May.

The children are doing really well with learning the words from our Year Three word list and are regularly applying them to all forms of writing. This half term's words are: arrive, build, decide, different, early, group, heard and often. Please support your child in learning them at home, alongside reading their library book which they can change on Wednesdays.
