

Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy New Year! We hope you've had a lovely break over Christmas. Here are a few notes about this term to help you understand what we are learning about and to give some extra information and useful reminders.

Our topic this half term will be *Night and Day!* We will be learning all about nocturnal and diurnal animals and where the sun goes at night. In English we will be reading a selection of books including *A Tale of Two Feathers* and *Funny Bones.* We will be sharing a short film which will be launched after school at our exciting *One Dark Night* event.

Our theme in Art will be Starry Night by Van Gogh. In maths we continue to learn to count, read and write numbers. We shall explore a range of calculations using addition and subtraction; we will also look at shapes and their properties.

In PE we will learn about spatial awareness within gymnastics, as well as mastering basic movements such as running, jumping and travelling. During music, we will practise rhythm and compose our own music. We would like to thank you for your continued support and welcome any volunteers in school or on our educational visits throughout the year.
