We will begin this half term's English by looking at and interpreting various WW2 poetry in order to write our own poems about the Blitz. We will also be reading and exploring Michael Morpugo's text Friend or Foe and exploring the characters in order to write a letter.	In maths we will be looking at statistics. We will be learning how to interpret and create our own line graphs and tables. We will also be completing a multiplication and division topic where we will be looking at multiplication factors, square numbers, prime numbers and cube numbers.	We will be continuing to investigate materials and their properties looking at interpreting and representing results in a variety of ways. This will include looking at electrical and thermal conductors and insulators, soluble and insoluble materials and separation.
