

Now that we are several weeks into the Autumn term, we have been looking at the attendance of our children in school. 265 of our children had 100% attendance up until October half term and many children will receive another reward when we get to Christmas. Please note that if children's attendance goes below 90% during the school year, this is classed as persistent absence. We understand that children can be unwell from time to time, but please note if your child's attendance figure is below 90%, we will require some form of medical evidence, for example, a medical note

from the doctor, an appointment card or sight of any medication prescribed.

Next week is On Time, Ready to Learn week. We will be rewarding children for their punctuality in arriving at school. There will again be a fantastic prize draw which all children who arrive by 9am will be entered into.
