

Attendance and Punctuality

We are committed to supporting all of our families in helping our children to have good attendance and punctuality and understand that children can be absent for many different, often unforeseen, reasons. Please can you make sure that if your child is absent, you inform the office of the reason for this so that we can record this accurately on our system. Should you have any difficulties with your child's attendance, please speak to the office in the first instance who can arrange for an informal chat with me to discuss your concerns. Children are classed as being persistently absent if they have been absent for over 10% of the year — this is equal to approximately 9 days at this point in the year. Our 'On Time, Ready to Learn' scheme continues to run this week. We will be giving raffle tickets to all children who were here on time over the last two weeks with a prize hamper for one of these children. The draw will take place in assembly on Friday.
