We will be sharing the story The Great Balloon Hullabaloo and designing a new character who lives on Mars. Next, we shall be learning all about the famous aviator Amelia Earhart and writing a biography of her life. Finally, we shall be investigating the first moon landing and writing a recount of the events.	We will be consolidating our addition and subtraction skills by learning to calculate using formal methods. We will then move on to focus on money, in particular, recognising coins and notes, learning how to count money and find totals as well as giving change. Finally, we shall begin to learn more about multiplication by making arrays and making and adding equal groups.	In science we will be continuing to describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food
