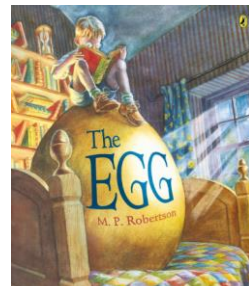
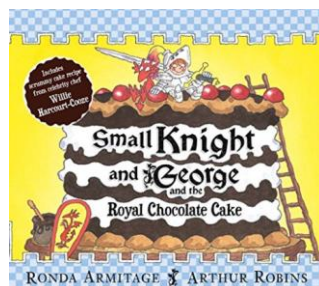


Welcome Back to school!

We hope you've had a lovely Easter break. Here are a few notes about this term to help you understand what we are learning about and to give some extra information and useful reminders.

PE Kit

Year One PE sessions are to be on **Wednesday** (indoor) and outdoors (weather permitting) on **Friday**. Please ensure your child wears the correct PE kit.



Our Topics

Our topic this term is called *I'm The King of the Castle* and we will be learning about castles, dragons, knights, kings and queens. We will be reading *Small knight* and *George and the Royal Chocolate Cake* and *The Egg* along with other stories.

In maths we will be learning to count, read and write numbers to 100 and do a range of calculations including adding and subtracting. We will also be looking at measurement.

In PE this term we will learn a medieval dance and enjoy team games.
