Dear Parents and Carers.

As you know, your child is taking part in Young Voices with the concert taking place on 3rd February 2022 at Sheffield Arena

You can click <u>here</u> if you would like to order audience tickets, which are priced at £20.00 per person. Please tick the amount of tickets required and then logon to scopay to purchase that amount of tickets (they are under the products tab).

On the above form you also have the opportunity to order a t-shirt pack for your child. These are priced at £12.00 and contain a T-shirt, a torch, a wristband, a VIP lanyard and a memory poster. Payment for the t-shirt pack will be added to your child's scopay account in due course. The t-shirt pack is optional and children can wear a plain white t-shirt on the day.

There is also a charge for the coach of £8.00. This has been added to your child's scopay account. If you have applied and are eligible for Free School Meals the cost of the coach will be subsidised by school. You can apply online for Free School Meals at www.bradford.gov.uk/schoolmeals

All order forms need to be completed by Friday 22nd October. T-shirt packs will be delivered to school about a week before the concert and given out a day or so before we go. We are unable to exchange t-shirts if the sizing is wrong.
